Under this agreement for 2017 Bouldercombe State School will receive

\$59,345*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in Maths to 83%.
- Maintain student percentages for NMS for both Literacy and Numeracy at 93% and higher for students in Year 3 and 5 achieving at or above NMS for NAPLAN.
- Increase U2B percentages for both Literacy and Numeracy for Year 3 and Year 5.

Our initiatives include

- Provide professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum: Mathematics learning area and provide targeted and scaffolded instruction to secure highly effective first teaching of essential mathematical concepts and skills in every classroom.
- Develop a shared understanding of 'data literacy' and support teachers and leadership teams to effectively use data to inform targeted teaching to continue to increase student gains.
- Develop teachers' capability to embed feedback in the teaching, learning cycle and effective moderation.
- Develop and invest in a whole school Higher Order thinking program to be embedded.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Upskill teachers in the use of OneSchool so that all teachers are using the developmental maps mark book, Individual Curriculum Plans, differentiation placemat, and dashboard functionality.
- Embed the culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice / action learning. (TRS \$1500)
- Continue implementation of Early Start and align data for early support to increase entry point for at risk students. (\$1500)
- Engage the services of experienced teacher/s or provide TRS to release teachers to support year level moderation once per term across neighbouring schools and twice a term within the whole school moderation meetings. (2 x Teachers Intervention Program \$48,000)
- Develop resources and implement a professional development and coaching program to support teachers in data gathering, collation, analysis and use. (TRS: \$8,000)
